October 1 is National Census Day; A Census Taker Will Visit Each Home at the End of September

On October 1st, a national census will be conducted throughout Japan. The national census is taken every five years and this year marks administration of the 17th major survey. The survey includes everyone — Japanese and foreigners — living in Japan. It is estimated that a total of about



127,000,000 people (47,000,000 households) in the country and about 85,000 people (36,000 households) in the city of Ashiya will be surveyed during the census.

• Important Survey to Be Used in Day-to-Day Living

The national census is used not only to obtain accurate figures concerning the population and number of households (by such categories as sex and age), but also to understand current trends like aging and low birthrate, the diversification of employment/hiring patterns, population movement, household structure and residents' situations and status. This is an important survey because the final numbers are used as reference for all types of governmental programs at the national, prefectural and municipal level.

• Survey Description

Date: As of 12 midnight October 1 (Sun.)

Eligibility: Everyone who lives in Japan (including foreign residents). **Survey Questions:** There are 22 items. These include: name; sex; year and month of birth; head of household and family rela-

tionships; spousal relationship; nationality; length of time at current address (address of residence five years ago); educational background, such as school of enrollment/graduation; employment, including work hours, name of place of employment, type of business, occupation, business title; location of place of employment or school; transportation used to work/school; type of household; number of household members; household income; type of construction of residence; size of residence.

Survey Method: From around September 20th to September 30th, a census taker will visit each household to ask for cooperation in completing the survey. Between October 1st and October 9th, the official will visit a second time to collect completed surveys. Residents who will be away from home during this period should contact the census taker or the telephone number below.

• Information is Kept Strictly Confidential

It is strictly prohibited by law for any information from the census surveys to be given to unauthorized people or used for any purpose other than calculating statistics. Thus, the privacy of individuals and households is protected. Please carefully read instructions on "How to complete the survey," use a pencil and complete the entire survey form accurately.

• If You Do Not Want the Census Taker to See Your Form

Please place your completed survey inside the "How to complete the survey" sheet, seal it shut with the attached "envelope sticker" and submit the completed survey in the sealed sheet to the census official. In this case, the official will submit the envelope unopened to the city office.

Ashiya's Seasons Pioneering Plants

What plants are growing in the new landfill area of Minami-hama in Ashiya?

Ashiya Environmental Planning and Promotion Council member Mr. Keiichi Furuichi conducted a survey of this area two years ago. "I was curious about what types of life would first take root on this new ground," he said. "And pursuing the changes that will take place there over time will be an important key to understanding the distribution of life."

The "shinagawahagi" (sweet clover), rare before in Ashiya, was found in large groups. It is a small tree that grows to approximately 1.5 meters. It is of Eastern Asian origin and the ends of the branches bloom in numerous tiny yellow flowers. The "shirobana shinagawahagi" (white sweet clover), of Central Asian origin, was also discovered, but in small numbers.

"Shirozakearitaso" (Chenopodium ambrosoides L. var. pubescens Mak.) of the goosefoot family was found scattered about while the "houkigiku" (Aster subulatus mickx.) was found in larger numbers.



"Okijimushiro" (Potentilla spina L.)

A more rare flower of the rose family, the "okijimushiro" (Potentilla spina L.) of Eurasian origin, was found blooming in a shade of yellow. Mr. Furuichi also saw the unusual flower of the "hosoba tsurunogeitou" (Alternanthera nodifiora R. Br.), a plant usually found in tropical areas of Asia.

Discovered alongside the roads used by the dump trucks were reddish-purple flowers of the "chichibu fujiutsugi" (Buddleja davidii Franch.), a foreignintroduced plant.

Mr. Furuichi's impression was that "the plant life found in this man-made land was overwhelmingly dominated by non-native plants. These could easily be called the pioneering plants. Then there were also some areas where ponds were found growing with domestic "himegama" (Typha angustata Presl.) and "tamakayatsuri" (Cyperus difformis L.)."

In his survey, Mr. Furuichi found 41 varieties of plants belonging to 15 families. The composite family was most

numerous with 13 varieties followed by the leguminous with six varieties.

Tax Q & A

Q: I have just received my city and prefectural tax payment invoice, but I am currently unemployed and have no income. I cannot make my tax payments. What should I do?

A: As city and prefectural taxes are calculated based on your income for the previous year, you are expected to pay it even if you have no income. However, if you have absolutely no means for paying the tax, if your total income for last year was ¥8,000,000 or less and you have been unemployed for more than one month prior to the payment deadline, you may be eligible for a tax payment reduction. Please attach documents verifying your unemployment to the application for tax payment reduction. Reductions in tax payments are available for not only unemployment and retirement, but also in the event of the taxed

person's death or a disaster. Please call the Resident Tax Subsection of the Taxation Section for more information. **Inquiries:** Taxation Section, Resident Tax Subsection (Tel: 38-2016)
