

# Please participate in the Population Census!

The Japanese government is conducting a Population Census beginning Oct. 1, 2005. All members of Japanese society are required to participate, regardless of nationality. The Census questionnaire will be distributed to each household by Census enumerators in during the end of September, and you must fill out the questionnaire form showing your status as of Oct. 1.

A Census enumerator will call on you sometime during first few weeks of October to collect the questionnaire form.

### Outline of the Census questionnaire form

#### **Privacy Policy**

To assure potential participants from you in this survey, all people related to this project, including enumerators, are required by law to keep any information they acquire confidential. Also, the information obtained from the Census will be treated confidentially and used only for statistical purposes. If you don't want the enumerators to see the contents of your completed questionnaire, you can seal it in the "Special Envelope for Population Census", which will be distributed to each household before you give your form to the enumerator. An enumerator must submit those envelopes to the municipal Census Desk without opening them. After the city accepts the sealed envelops, they will be opened and checked only by a city officer. If the officer finds the form is incomplete, he/she will contact you by phone to confirm the missing information. Therefore, be sure not to forget to write your phone number down on the form. ## Proclamation Declaring Ashiya a Non-Nuclear City

The Rokko mountainsides, their rich greenery and fresh air, their natural beauty - this is our treasure, and we wish to leave it in inheritance to children of the future.

Nevertheless, as if flaunting this aspiration, nuclear weapons continue to multiply, pushing the world to the brink of extinction. Nuclear disarmament, a life or death issue for the human race, can only be seen as the most urgent concern facing us today.

Trusting in the reason and resolution of people throughout the world as repeatedly expressed since World War II, in order to bequeath this irreplaceable planet of life, this clear and shining Earth, to children yet to be born, we once more unite our voices and hearts to call to the world to rid all countries of nuclear weapons. With hope that Japan will strictly adhere to the three antinuclear principles of its national policy, we resolve that our city, Ashiya, will in no way allow the use of nuclear weapons, and we hereby declare it a Non-Nuclear city.
