This is a time of the year prone to fire, and this campaign is aimed at enhancing fire preparedness efforts, preventing fire, minimizing the number of fatal cases particularly among the elderly, and avoiding loss of

As regards housing fire safety, the death toll in house fires since 2003 has surpassed 1,000 for five consecutive years. Due to the gravity of the situation, new houses are now mandated to be equipped with fire alarm systems, and resident of existing housing are also being asked to install them at the earliest possible time. Furthering awareness and knowledge of fire prevention saves lives and that is our mission.

Main Goals

Housing Fire Prevention

"Seven Points to Save Lives from Fire"

- 1. Never smoke in bed.
- 2. Never use stove heaters near easily burnable items.
- 3. Be sure to turn off gas cooking stoves, gas heaters, etc. when unattended.
- 4. Install a housing fire alarm for quick exit in case of fire.
- 5. Use furniture, clothing, curtains made of fireproof material.
- 6. Keep a fire extinguisher at hand at all times for the first sign of fire.
- 7. With help of your neighbors, set up a system to assist the elderly and the disabled.

How to Protect from Arsonists and Serial Arson

It is important that every resident be on the alert to actively prevent cases of arson, and for other administrative offices, organizations, businesses, and neighborhood associations to act as one, and not just temporarily but on a continual basis.

The key point is to not allow conditions for arson.

- 1. Do not leave burnable things around or near your house.
- 2. Keep the outside of your house well-lighted.
- 3. Use fireproof covers for your car or scooter.

November 9th is "119 Ban Day" (Emergency Day) Be ready for emergencies

Keep a memo with your address, telephone number and other relevant information at hand, and make sure to speak calmly and give the correct directions.

★When dialing 119 make sure to:

1. Say fire or emergency.
Say clearly Kaji! ("Fire!") or Kyukyu! ("Ambulance").
2. Tell the exact location of the site.

Besides the correct address, tell if it is near a particular building, park or other easy to find landmark

3. Tell the extent of the fire or accident.

Explain the situation in detail

4. Make sure to give your name and phone number.


