Walk around Ashiya's historic places.

1. Shinnozuka (The Barrow of Prince Abo)

The Barrow of Prince Abo built in approx. 1700 years ago is known as the place Prince Abo Shinno is enshrined. It is now closed and managed by the Imperial Household Agency.

The perimeter of the monument is around 365m. The mound has a diameter of about 36m. The height is about 3m.

In Yamaguchi Prefectural Archives, ancient documents of the Barrow of Prince Abo are stored.

2. Nakano-ike Pond Green Space

You can observe birds, insects and aquatic plants and animals in the pond among the rich ecosystems. The Castanopsis and Quercus are planted to make the site inhabitable for birds and insects. Reeds and wild rice are arranged to take care of the habitat by the edge of the pond. There are also a canal, lanes and a cabin for observation.

3. Iwagahira Park (Montebello Rose Garden) 3-B

Montebello City (USA) and Ashiya City became sister cities in 1961. Plenty of roses, the city flower of Montebello, were sent to Ashiya city.

To celebrate this friendship, the Rose Garden was created in Iwa-gahira Park.

In early spring, cherry blossoms and colorful roses bloom magnificently

In fall, you can enjoy the spectacular Autumn leaves.

4. Asahigaoka Remains

The Asahigaoka Remains, discovered in 1964, are complex remains of the Paleolithic and *Jomon* periods. Complex remains are rare in the Hanshin region. Stoneware potteries and earthenware were unearthed here.

Haptic models displayed outdoors help you to understand at a glance the relationship between the remains and the topography. Artifacts and specimens are on display in the assembly hall next to the remains.

5. Ashiya Cemetery

Ashiya cemetery has plenty of plants such as azaleas and cherry blossoms. The grass field, canals and walking paths are well maintained.

Glorious views of Ashiya city and Osaka bay can be overlooked from its observatory.

In Spring, visitors can enjoy 2,000 cherry trees blooming together with a great view of Sakura-sando Street that becomes a tunnel of cherry in the season.


