Saving the Earth from Global Warming

People all over the world are working together to limit carbon dioxide emissions, the leading cause of global warming. The Japanese government works to raise awareness of the problems created by global warming by promoting December as Global Warming Prevention Month and Air Pollution Prevention Promotion Month. Ashiya has also drafted its own Environmental Preservation Initiatives Plan, and promotes efforts to reduce greenhouse gases to prevent global warming.

To leave the Earth healthy for future generations, it is important that we educate ourselves about global warming, think about what we can do to help the Earth today, and begin by making small changes in our own lives.

What You Can Do: At Home

- Cut off the power supply to electrical appliances, turn off lights when not in use. ("Turn it off! Campaign")

 • Set your thermostat to 20°C or lower.
- Don't leave water running or keep the gas on any longer than necessary. This will help save energy.

What You Can Do: In Your Car

- Keep driving to a minimum. Ride a train, bus or bicycle to your destination. (No Driving Day in the Hanshin Region)
- Turn off the engine when your car is standing still. (No Idling Campaign)
- Observe speed limits and avoid gunning the motor and accelerating violently. (Auto Pollution Prevention Month)

These efforts will reduce carbon dioxide emissions and help prevent air pollution.

Identification To Be Checked When Registering Marriage, etc.

From February 1, Ashiya City will begin checking the identification of those who come in to report changes (marriage, divorce, adoption and dissolution of adoption).

Individuals reporting changes should be prepared to present a piece of government-issued photo identification (such as a driver's license or passport) or a health insurance certificate.

Individuals who do not have proof of identification may also report changes, but the registry holder will be notified by mail that the change has been made to the registry.
