Announcement from Health Insurance and Pension Section

Rates for National Health Insurance Premiums Set

Inquiries: Health Insurance Subsection, Health Insurance and Pension Section, Tel: 38-2035

Annual insurance premiums: The annual insurance premium to be paid by households that include any person aged 40 to 64 years of age is the sum of the "medical insurance coverage" and "long-term care insurance coverage." The premium to be paid by other households is the amount for "medical insurance coverage" only.

FY2004 National Health Insurance Premium Rates Figures in parentheses () are for FY 2003.

Medical Insurance Coverage

Percentage of income: 6.2% (5.5%) Per capita amount: \$31,560 (\$28,440) per person Per household amount: \$22,800 (\$20,760) per household Maximum total premium: \$530,000 (\$520,000)

Long-Term Care Insurance Coverage

Percentage of income: 1.8% (1.4%) Per capita amount: \$8,280 (\$7,320) per person Per household amount: \$4,560 (\$3,960) per household Maximum total premium: \$80,000 (\$70,000)

* Calculations are based on the standard gross income in 2003.

- * Premiums consist of the income-based amount, the per capita amount and the per household amount.
- * The standard gross income is calculated by subtracting the net loss carried forward and the Resident Tax basic deduction (¥330,000) from total income. Other income deductions do not apply.

Individuals Having Problems Paying their National Pension Premiums Can Apply for Exemption

If you are having problems paying your National Pension premiums due to a reduction in income or unemployment, you may apply for an exemption from payments. Exemption decisions will be based on the income reported for the previous year for the applicant, spouse and the head of household.

Total exemption: Exempts the applicant from paying the total premium (\$13,300). Once the exemption is approved, the individual concerned will be credited with having paid one-third of the pension amount for the exemption period.

Half exemption: Exempts the applicant from paying half of the total premium (\$6,650). Once the exemption is approved, the individual concerned will be credited with having paid two-thirds of the pension amount for the exemption period.

Announcement from the Medical Assistance Subsection

Hospitalization Welfare Benefit System will be abolished on October 1

Payments of the standard costs for meals and medical expenses of medical services welfare recipients who are also recipients of the Special Medical Expense Assistance for Elderly Mentally or Physically Handicapped Persons, such as households with infants or mentally or physically handicapped persons (children) or single-parent families, will only be made until September.

A certificate will be issued that indicates that the holder is eligible for "Limits on Medical Expenses for the Elderly, and for Standard Cost Reductions"

The costs of medical and meal expenses incurred during hospitalization will be reduced for holders of the Medical Services Recipient Certificate who fall into one of the following categories. (Applicants must bring a Health Insurance Certificate, Health and Medical Services Law Medical Care Certificate for the Elderly and registered personal stamp to apply.)

Members of households not subject to the resident tax: Monthly medical expenses during hospitalization will be reduced from $\pm 40,200$ to $\pm 24,600$, and meal expenses will be reduced from $\pm 780/day$ to $\pm 650/day$. If the applicant was hospitalized for 90 or more days during the 12 months prior to the month in which they applied, the meal expenses from the first day of the month following the month in which they applied will be reduced to $\pm 500/day$. To apply for this additional benefit, the applicant must provide a hospital receipt verifying the number of days he/she was hospitalized in addition to the above required items.

Members of households not subject to resident tax and with no income earners: Monthly medical expenses during hospitalization will be reduced from $\frac{40,200}{15,000}$, and meal expenses will be reduced from $\frac{780}{4300}$ to $\frac{1000}{300}$.

For those who have their certificate valid until July 31

Applications forms were sent out in July. Be sure to renew your certificate if you are still eligible.




Emergency services

In case of emergency, call for an ambulance from the fire department (telephone 119).


