Procedures for Receiving Supplementary Income Payments (*Teigaku Kyufukin*) & Special Allowance to Support Child-Rearing

■An application form and a return envelope were sent on March 16 to eligible residents.

Individuals who have not yet submitted their application are requested to do so by September 18, 2009 (if by mail, postmarked by the same date). (The application form was sent by the municipality where you were registered on February 1, 2009)

■ Please understand that in case the application does not meet the deadline it will be considered as to have been withdrawn.

■ Eligible residents, applicants and recipients

Supplementary Income Payments (Teigaku Kyufukin) Ashiya residents registered in the City's Basic Resident Register or Foreign Registration Record as of February 1, 2009 (excluding those with short-term resident status and/or illegal residents) are eligible to the following payments:

. ♦Persons aged 65 or older, or aged 18 or younger: 20,000 yen per person (born on or before February 2, 1944, or born on or after February 2, 1990) Other ages: 12,000 yen per person

▶Special Allowance to Support Child-Rearing

Ashiya residents registered in the City's Basic Resident Register or Foreign Registration Record as of February 1, 2009 (excluding those with short-term resident status and/or illegal residents) born between April 2, 2002 and April 1, 2005, and that are the second child or younger.

Allowance: 36,000 yen per person

Please inform if any of the children has residence outside Ashiya.

♦ Criterion for determining the second child: The first child is a child born between April 2, 1990 and April 1, 2005. Any child born either before or after that period will not be counted in the calculation for determining "second child or younger".

■Application (and receipt) by a representative other than the head of the household can be done by any of the following persons:

1 A person who belongs to the same household (a statement of reason

2A foreign national who lives with or resides at the same location as the head of the household and is codependent for livelihood as of February 1, 2009;

3A legal representative of the head of the household;

Anyone recognized as a suitable representative by the Mayor of Ashiya.

■Application Procedures

Applications can be filed in three different ways.

Mailing: The applicant mails the application form and a bank transfer will be made to a designated account.

2In-person: The applicant submits the application directly at the City Hall and a bank transfer will be made to a designated account.

3In-person cash disbursement: The applicant submits the application directly at the City Hall and receives payment in cash at the counter in charge(Only for those who have no bank account or find bank transfer inconvenient)

■We strongly recommend the mailing method. Required documents:

Application Form for Supplementary Income Payments (fill out the form by referring to the attached Entry Guide, entering the bank account information and other relevant

2A copy of the applicant's ID (Foreign Registration Card, driver's license, passport, etc.)

3A copy of the bankbook (reverse side of the cover or cash card showing name of financial institution, account number, account holder's name) Send the three items above in the return envelope.

How to Discard Paper Cartons

1.Empty contents and rinse well; 2.Cut open;

3.Dry up;

4. Tie with a string;
5. Take out on the 4th week Wednesday.

Note: ONLY white paper cartons are recyclable as paper cartons. If you find the same recyclable as paper cartons. If you find aluminum coating on the inside when cutting open, discard it on "magazines, fliers and various papers" day. It cannot be recycled so do not take out together with white paper carton

Bulky (large-sized) or Temporary Large Amounts of Garbage are collected at a fee by request. Depending on the amount of work, not all garbage may be collected on the desired day, so please make an early reservation.

Individual city/prefecture resident taxes are assessed every year on individuals who were living in Ashiya City as of January 1, and a fixed assets & city planning tax are levied every year on those who owned fixed property (land, buildings or depreciable properties) as of January 1. Even if you have left Ashiya after January 1, you ought to pay the taxes.

Light Vehicle Taxes

Owners of light vehicles (including motorbikes) are taxed on April 1 of every year.


